TALKING POINTS

To be shared with stakeholder groups

1. The Strategic Planning Committee (SPC) selected by the superintendent represents a broad group of district stakeholders – parents, community, board, teachers, district and site administration, classified staff, and students.
2. Strategic Planning Committee documents are posted on the District website under “Strategic Plan.”
3. SPC will meet 4 times and present the new Strategic Plan Part 1 “The What” to the Board in November/December – Vision, Mission, Strategic Directions and Student Will Statements. The Strategic Plan Part 2 “The How” will be developed by the staff and presented to the Board in February – Action Plan, Who Responsible, Timeline, Success Indicators. The SPC will meet annually in February to hear a progress report and give feedback to the Strategic Plan. Progress will be reported annually to the staff and community.
4. The SPC looked at a series of videos on 21st century student learning concepts focused on Innovation-Creativity-Technology-Common Core. They also reviewed the ideas from the teacher and parent/community forums held last spring and the recommendations to the SPC from the Leadership Team’s 7 Revolution workshop held this fall.
5. The SPC table groups created 6 big ideas from the discussion and shared with the full group. The Strategic Directions for the new Strategic Plan will be developed from these “Big Idea” themes.
