***Re: Commuter Benefits Available to San Mateo-Foster City School District Employees***

In compliance with Senate Bill 1339, which was signed into law in 2012, the San Mateo-Foster City School District offers Commuter Benefits to all interested employees.

The District allows employees to claim commuter expenses, to and from work, through our Section 132(f) plan on a pre-tax basis.

Expenses under Sections 132(f) are as follows:

- Mass Transit (i.e. BART, Muni bus and rail, Caltrain, AC Transit, etc.) – Maximum \$265.00 per month
- Parking – Maximum \$265 per month

The District contracted with My Commuter Check to provide you the tax free commuter benefits program. The amount you ordered will be deducted from your current pay check as pre-tax expenses. In addition, there is a \$3 handling fee per month only for the month that you participate in the program. The \$3 is not a pre-tax expense
