The teacher's role is to observe the children and demonstrate challenging materials for them to explore. The materials are self-correcting and designed to be used in a specific way. There are practical life experiences: cooking, sweeping, cleaning, self care, pet care, and gardening as well as lessons in geography, math, shapes, music, and art.
