San Mateo-Foster City School District Holds Hearings on By-Trustee Area Elections

Foster City, CA—At their meeting last night, the Board of Trustees of the San Mateo-Foster City School District (SMFCSD) approved a resolution affirming their intention to transition from at-large to a by-trustee area election system and announced the first two of four public hearings inviting the public to provide input regarding the composition of the trustee districts.

SMFCSD trustees are currently elected "at-large," meaning candidates are required to reside within given areas of the county and the voters of the *entire* county elect the candidates to the Board. In a "by-trustee area" election, one candidate residing in each trustee area is elected only by the registered voters in that particular trustee area. These first two SMFCSD hearings on by-trustee area elections will be held on:

June 22, 2021 – First public hearing to receive community comments and public testimony concerning the composition of potential trustee voting areas associated with the Board's transition to a by-trustee area election system.

June 29, 2021 – Second public hearing to receive community comments and public testimony concerning the composition of potential trustee voting areas associated with the Board's transition to a by-trustee area election system.
