

Senate Bill 792 (SB792)

In the San Mateo-Foster City School District, our most important goal is encouraging our families to be actively involved in their child's education and this starts in preschool!

Thank you for taking time to better understand the importance of submitting your proof of vaccines per <u>California State Senate Bill 792</u>. This law requires any parent, guardian, grandparent, au pair, nanny, etc. wishing to enter a preschool classroom for any reason (including: volunteering, classroom activities, projects, field trips, etc.) must provide proper documentation.

Proof of the following immunizations is required:

- ✓ Influenza (A current vaccine)
- ✓ MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)
- ✓ TDaP (Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis)
- ✓ TB Skin Test (Tuberculosis)

I know that this law is surprising for some families, but we are <u>mandated</u> to follow the guidelines from the State.
