### 2013-14 Budget

- Unchanged from Draft presented to Board on June 6, 2013
  - State Budget not yet signed into law by the Governor

### State Budget

- ❖ Legislature adopted 2013-14 budget package June 14 & 15
  - Pending Governor's signature June 30 deadline
- Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF) compromise NEW
  - Retains LCFF grant elements Base, Supplemental, Concentration
  - Increase <u>Base Grant</u> amounts on average \$500 per ADA
  - Supplemental Grant rate reduced to 20% of Base amount from 35%
  - Concentration Grant rate increased to 50% of Base amount from 35%, but student count threshold increased to 55% from previous 50%
  - Implementation timeline increased to 8 years
  - Major addition of Economic Recovery Target (ERT) ensure districts' pre-recession funding levels will be restored by 2020-21



### State Budget (cont.)

#### More to come

- Budget Trailer Bills will be needed technical fixes
- Amendments correction of unintended consequences
- Implementation language clarifications and interpretations
- Technical details will be provided by School Services of California at the July 18, 2013 workshop
