

SCHOOL SAFETY PLANS

Each school in the San Mateo -Foster City School District completes a school safety plan, and updates it on an annual basis. The annual review and evaluation of the School Comprehensive School Safety Plan is reviewed and certified by members of the School Site Council and the School Principal. The review includes the following mandated components of Senate Bill 187.

- Child abuse reporting procedures
- Policies pursuant to Education Code 48915 and other school designated serious acts which would lead to suspension, expulsion or mandatory expulsion recommendations.
- Procedures to notify teachers and counselors of dangerous students
- Sexual Harassment Policy
- Safe ingress and egress to and from school
- Rules and procedures on school discipline in order to create a safety and orderly environment conducive to learning
- Dress code
- Routine and emergency disaster procedures including natural disasters, human created disasters or power outages
